Saturday and Sunday have even seen a few

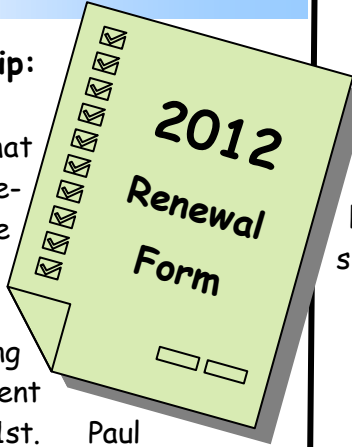

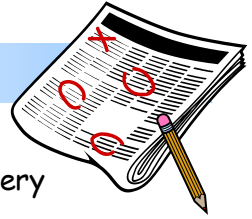

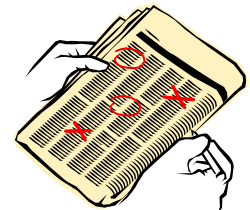

# Minutes of the Board Meeting 1-17-12

Meeting called to order 1900.

Board Members present: Gary Jolley, Bob Robinson, Chet Britz, John Coovert, Paul Richardson, Brad Newman, Jack McGreevy.

Guests: Jim Carlsen, Gene Lambert

## Treasurer's Report:

Chet Britz presented the Treasurer's report. Paul Richardson moved to accept, seconded by John Coovert. Motion passed.

## Vice Commodore's Report:

Bob Robinson indicated the date of the Frostbite Race to be March 24, not March 28, as previously published in the Event Calendar. Bob indicated that he would be downloading the latest version of Sail-wave to be used for scoring in next season's racing. He also indicated that the scoring PC (probably a laptop) would be available in the Clubhouse the day of the race, and that he may be getting a wireless printer to be used to publish the results. He stated that the Committee Boat would need to be manned on a scheduled basis, and that he would not be overseeing it with the same close attention provided last year. Paul Richardson pointed out that the updated Membership Application/Renewal form has a space to indicate if the person wished to assist with the Committee Boat, and that he would forward those people's names to Bob.

## Rear Commodore's Report:

Rear Commodore was not present.

## Membership Chair Report:

Paul Richardson reported that we have 40 active memberships for 2012 at this time. He requested that an announcement be made at the Crab Feed for members to renew prior to February 1<sup>st</sup> in order to be included in the Membership Roster for 2012.

## Social Chair Report:

Brad Newman reported that everything was a go for the Crab Feed, and that we had 80 total participants at this time. The room holds 88 total. There was some discussion of adding tables on the enclosed patio, but it was unknown how comfortable these would be in the month of January. It was determined to limit the event to



88 participants.

## OLD BUSINESS

**Konocti Cup Update:** Jim Carlsen, as Konocti Cup Chairman, reported that the Welcome Letter has gone out, and that the Course change had been approved (moving buoy 5 out of the shadows and buoy 2 further towards Kono Tayee to compensate for the distance lost in moving buoy 5). He and the Commodore discussed the need to have sponsors lined up prior to the February Board Meeting and the Commodore charged each of the Board Members with signing up two sponsors. The benefits to the sponsor were determined to be: two free Brunch tickets, logo/business card on Tshirt, logo/business card on the KCup web page, logo/business card on the sponsor's board, recognition of sponsors during the Brunch proceedings.



**KBSC Event Calendar:** The 2012 Calendar is to be published in the next newsletter, with many thanks to T.J. Mickel for getting that done.

## NEW BUSINESS:

**Media Center:** At the Crab Feed, Gary Jolley intends to solicit for a donation of a TV set to be used in the clubhouse as the focal point of a media center.

**Sea Scouts:** Brad Newman brought forth some requests from the Sea Scouts, indicating that they had need for a trailer for a Balboa, assistance with ensuring the seaworthiness of the three Lido 14s that were available to them, and some sailing instruction for their membership. Some possible solutions were discussed and Brad Newman was going to follow up with contacts provided.



**Clubhouse Dedication:** It was determined that a Clubhouse Dedication ceremony will be held on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday of May, May 19<sup>th</sup>.

Meeting was adjourned at 2021.

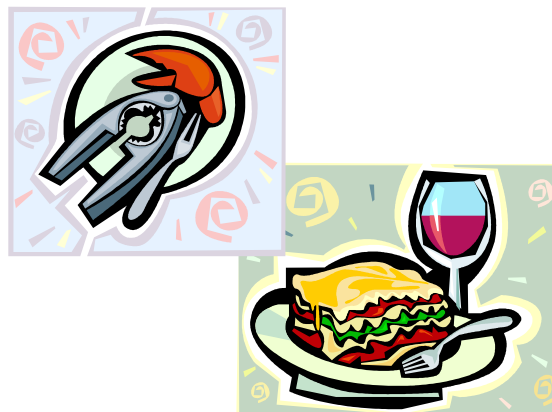
